What is Ash Wednesday? The day after Pancake Tuesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent. Ashes, in the shape of a cross are applied to the forehead, a sign of repentance for sin - a reminder that we are human, that we fall short of God's glory, that we will die one day. Choosing to identify with Christ's humanity gives us greater identification with Jesus' suffering on our behalf and therefore a deeper joy on Easter Sunday, the day Jesus' grave was discovered to be empty, that Jesus had risen from the dead. 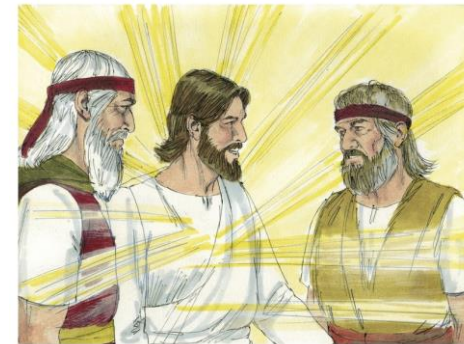
